Cozumel, Mexico Hosts International Athletes at Mexico's First-Ever Ironman Competition

Cozumel, Mexico hosted close to 2,000 athletes Sunday, November 29 for Mexico's first ever Ironman Competition. Cozumel was selected as one of the World Triathlon Corporation's Ironman locations this year, along with major cities including Zurich, Switzerland; Lake Placid, NY; Nice, France and Frankfurt, Germany.
